### ARCH'S LONGSHOTS

Always back up your WIN bet with PLACE money if the horse is 5-to-1 or higher!

- 1st: SILENT EXPLOIT wasn't disgraced 5/28; might still be decent odds.
- 2nd: BESTISYETOCOME comes off our First-Time Starter Report (below).
- 3rd: RAN FOR THE DOUGH has been freshened; 21% jockey/trainer team.
- 4th: CLAYMONT was pitched too high classwise on 5/28; rebound time.
- 5th: JAKE THE CHIEF made our First-Time Starter Report (below); price.
- 6th: FABULOUS GROOM had traffic problems on 5/18; been freshened.
- 7th: QUALITY ARMOR is returned to P. Val; beware, brother, beware...
- 9th: LAZY LAINEY wasn't asked when well beaten 5/28; jockey remains.

### ARCH'S LONGSHOTS

Always back up your WIN bet with PLACE money if the horse is 5-to-1 or higher!

- 1st: CLASSIC FOOL might get a wake-up call with 'blinkers off' this out.
- 4th: JOHNNY MCARTHY finished with interest in that 6/4 sprint; bred 'turf'.
- 5th: C. J. HAWK comes off our First-Time Starter Report (below); follow.
- 6th: ISLA MUJERES remains lightly raced; bred impeccably for the turf.
- 7th: ALOHA MANGOS KITTY made our First-Time Starter Report (below).
- 9th: DYNAWHITE benefits from strong jockey/trainer ties; has some zip.
- 10th: PARKER VALLEY should fit much better here in the Bay Area; odds?
- 11th: EXCESS INTEREST is another benefitting from the 'blinkers off' play.

### THE TRIANGLE FIRST-TIME STARTER & OVERSEAS HORSE REPORT

Comments on selected Maiden first-timers & invaders from overseas - This feature pertains to all entrants and not just our top three contenders

- HOL (2nd): BESTISYETOCOME draws a high-profile rider for a low-profile barn (good angle play); workouts are likely better than they look; contender.
- HOL (2nd): ADAMANT rates a look per that :47 flat gate drill on 6/1 at Santa Anita; sire gets a lot of winners; strange choice of riders, however; chance.
- HOL (5th): PRESENT THE CORK has things going for him including solid workouts and a trainer who does well with first-timers; very difficult to dismiss.
- HOL (5th): JAKE THE CHIEF can run some based on his last two a.m. moves (both 1:00 flat from the gate); Hess barn's 27% with their first-timers; bham!
- HOL (5th): MAJESTIC AVENUE exits a steady (every 7-8 days) a.m. slate and draws a top jockey; CA sire gets a lot of winners (this is a state-bred race).
- GG (2nd): CHEROKEE KISS has trained well enough to beat these per our a.m. sources; there's a reason she's debuting at the bottom but that's OK.
- GG (2nd): BELLE DE SABOTEUR comes off a series of respectable works down at Bay Meadows and might be OK; trainer can get a first-time ready.
- GG (5th): C. J. HAWK has worked quite well of late and the drills were at the distance of today's race (a big positive); spotted for a good effort today.
- GG (5th): QUAGMIRE shows slower workouts than C. J. HAWK (above) but the high-percentage stable doesn't try to win races in the mornings; follow.
- GG (7th): MUSIC AND MAGIC was auctioned for 135K in March after a pair of good workouts so they're obviously looking to 'win early' with this filly.
- GG (7th): ALOHA MANGOS KITTY exits a sharp a.m. slate at Pleasanton; they like her enough to race here instead of waiting for that meet to open.
- GG (11th): TOO MUCH PINE TAR was a veterinarian scratch on 6/3 (a 16K Mdn-Claimer) and comes back here for 8K (not a good sign); let's see a race.

### 4 IMPORTANT RULES ON HOW BEST TO USE OUR FEATURES (ABOVE)

- #1 It's been the case for a 100 years - the best way to win at the races is by selectively betting to WIN or WIN & PLACE. That's the golden rule.
- #2 When playing Triangle top selections and/or Arch's longshots, always back up your win bet with place money if the horse is 5-to-1 or higher.
- #3 Of all the 'exotic' forms of wagering, studies show that playing the Daily Double produces the most winners, followed by the Quinella/Exacta.
- #4 If you must play the Trifecta, use one (or two) of our horses as your 'key' and 'wheel' them to others in the 2nd & 3rd slots. Do not 'box' horses.
