Distance and Surface

Distance and Surface of what?

Well, Distance (the DIST in the header DIST/SURF) indicates how many furlongs or miles and furlongs there were in the horse's last race. The Digest lists distances in numerals, such as 6, 6-1/2, and 7, which translates to six furlongs, six-and-a-half furlongs, and seven furlongs, respectively. A 1 designates races at one mile, while additional distances beyond one mile are noted in fraction format, such as 1-1/8. (Example: If a horse last started at 1-1/8, his last race occurred at one-and-one-eighth mile or nine furlongs.)

Important! There are eight furlongs in one mile.

Surface (the SURF in the header DIST/SURF) tells the handicapper what kind of "footing" the horse raced over. Surfaces include dirt and synthetic (a combination of dirt and a whole bunch of other man-made stuff) and turf or grass. Dirt and synthetic surfaces carry no designation, while a "T" following the distance indicates a turf race.

CANTEEN

Canteen likes the turf. His last five races have all come over the grass. How can you tell? Because of the "T" designation following the distance. For example, Canteen's May 16 race is listed under DIST/SURF as 6FT. The numeral indicates the distance, which is in this case six furlongs (the "F" is for furlongs and is not always noted), while the "T" designation tells the handicapper the race was on the grass. Canteen's Nov 2 race came at 1T, or one mile on turf.

Has Canteen competed on the dirt in any of his last six races? Yes. On Oct 4 at Santa Anita/Oak Tree (SAO) the DIST/SURF of his race is listed as 6-1/2. Note that there is no "T" designation. That indicates it was a dirt or synthetic track race.

Important! You might have noticed the ♦ symbol to the left of a few of the distances that Canteen competed at. That's the Digest's way of telling you those races occurred more than 90 days ago. It's just another aid to help the handicapper.
