

Del Mar full card analysis for Saturday (8-1-15)

DMR 1 (C1m-16k, 8f) **#4 MOONLIGHT MEETING** (4-1) drops into a winning spot *2nd off the shelf* and Baltas shows a profit sprint/route. He figures in the hunt throughout under Prat. **#1 Indian Nate** (5-2) got a decent spin (4th, beaten 1 length) over the local oval July 16 and he might improve *2nd off the shelf* for Sadler. **#5 American Act** (2-1) was nabbed out his last by profitable *first off the claim* trainer Miyadi. He has finished 2nd in four straight (last win April 2012). **THE PLAYS: #4 to win, Quinella 1-4, Trifecta 1-4/1-4-5/1-4-5**

DMR 2 (C1m-8k, 8f) **#2 NOBLE KENT** (6-1) drops for quality trainer Mathis. He sports two dirt wins and will try to get involved late. **#5 Tester** (7-2) had his 2-race win streak snapped off a layoff at Los Al July 12. D'Amato is dangerous in two turn dirt routes and with *2nd off the shelf* runners and this one looks like a solid late running threat. **#8 Accelerant** (6-1) drops *3rd off the shelf* and all four of his career wins were at a flat mile. **THE PLAYS: #2 to win, Quinella 5/2-8**

DMR 3 (C1m-50k, 8T) **#4 CURRENCY EXCHANGE** (6-1) won down the dip June 14 and he's bred for two turns (Curlin/Rahy). Bejarano is 4-for-9 with Marquez and he should get pace to chase. **#1 Jazzy Josh** (4-1) is back at his claimed level for Miller and his last win was at this trip. **#2 Global Magician** (3-1) is also trained by Miller and he's tagged for the first time. **#5 Rockin Robin** (10-1) stretches back out and shows up for sale. He reunites with winning rider Baze and might show speed. **THE PLAYS: #4 to win, Quinella 4/1-2-5**

DMR 4 (C1m-25k, 6.5f) **#1 CHIA LOVE** (4-1) drops, switches surfaces, and turns back for the productive Bejarano/Baltas team. I am looking for a strong finishing kick today. **#8 Mothernaturespell** (3-1) owns early/pressing versatility for O'Neill (5 wins Wednesday) and Perez rode him well June 28. **#2 Yes Yes Baroness** (7-2) was freshened after beating \$32k claimers at Santa Anita June 7. She'll be finishing under Talamo. **THE PLAYS: #1 to win, Quinella 1/2-8**

DMR 5 (MSW, 5.5f) **#5 LOOK ME IN THE EYE** (3-1) dueled and finished a solid 3rd as the favorite in his debut June 26 and new pilot Bejarano does business with Puype. **#7 Tengas Ransom** (5-2) finished a good 2nd from the inside post in his local debut for Baze/Mullins. **#8 Captain Akers** (9-2) was a length in front of my top June 26 and was a 1/2 length behind *Tengas Ransom* July 17. He switches to Talamo and should show speed. **THE PLAYS: #5 to win, Quinella 5/7-8**

DMR 6 (Alw-1x, 5T) **#1 LAMONTAGNE** (7-2) captured her last two turf sprints in NY and looks like a solid *ship and win* threat for Ward. The runner-up from her last returned to score and Stevens hops aboard the early/pressing type. Her lone loss in three turf sprints was a place finish behind *International Star* last June. **#8 Pattitude** (6-1) was competitive in both previous turf sprint tries. She looked good graduating in the Churchill slop June 20 and was an okay 3rd in her first start for Puype here July 18. **#4 Sensitively** (3-1) looked great in her debut before fading to last and falling after the finish (vanned off) as the favorite when last seen in the Santa Paula April 5. **#7 Sweet Spell** (4-1) graduated in her long ago downhill debut and was put on the shelf after finishing a close third in her second career start March 2014. **THE PLAYS: #1 to win, Quinella 1-8, Exacta 1-8/4-7**

DMR 7 (MSW, 5.5f) **#3 FOREVER DARLING** (8-1) debuts for the productive Bejarano/Baltas team. She finished strong in her local July 29 gate move and might come out firing. **#2 Oh Great Idea** (5-2) drilled a local gate bullet July 17 for Miller, who also saddles **#10 Shakti** (7-2). The latter impressed clockers here July 23. **#4 One Last Shot** (3-1) debuts for the cold Garcia/Baffert team. She looked good in a local gate move July 24 and might get the barn going again. **#5 Flying Tinkerbelle** (15-1) sports two local bullets for Canani. **THE PLAYS: #3 to win, Trifecta 2-3-10/2-3-10/2-3-4-5-10**

DMR 8 (G1 Clement L. Hirsch, 8.5f) **#1 BEHOLDER** (6-5) has won her last three and might be too classy for these. She is fresh and training well. **#8 Thegirlinthat song** (5-1) seems to like this oval based on her three good looking local works and she appears to be ready to fire a fresh shot for Hollendorfer. **#2 Honey Ride** (10-1) exits an easy win vs. lesser and drilled a strong local bullet July 25. She owns an ascending numbers pattern and can be used in the exotics. **THE PLAYS: Superfecta 1/2-8/2-8/ALL, Superfecta 1/2-8/ALL/2-8, Superfecta 1/ALL/2-8/2-8**

DMR 9 (OC-40k, 8.5f) **#5 JUST KIDDING** (5-1) exits an easy Los Al maiden win for the productive Bejarano/Eurton team. Trainer shows a profit with his recent grads trying winners for the first time. **#1 Yahoo Tahoe** (10-1) is a *first time gelding* and Avila is 4-for-8 *first off the claim*. Espinoza was 2-for-2 with this barn here last year. **#7 Perfect Set** (3-1) exits an easy win at Los Al and fired a local bullet for this July 28. **#8 Smooth Roller** (7-2) cruised in his extended sprint bow June 27 and was flattered when the runner-up returned to score. **THE PLAYS: #5 to win, Quinella 1-5, Exacta 1-5/7-8**

DMR 10 (MSW, 8T) **#4 SECOND SUMMER** (6-1) caught the slop in his much needed local return July 19. He was a closing 3rd (beaten 1/2 length) in his lone turf outing here last fall and might look much improved on the surface switch. **#7 Dylan Ward** (3-1) moves to the D'Amato barn. He's usually in the mix (7-0-4-2) and today's pilot Bejarano rode him to a place finish when last seen here November 2014. **#11 Tirpitz** (5-1) hit the board in his last two downhill sprints and looms a solid threat if he handles two turns from the outside post. **#8 Lamaan** (6-1) earned an improved number from the outside post in a similar flat mile turf affair June 28. The new gelding adds blinkers and might improve again. **#5 Mixio** (20-1) debuts for Gary Mandella and he shows a profit with first timers. Quality turf rider Prat takes the call and he sports a few fast Santa Anita works for this. **THE PLAYS: #4 to win, Quinella 7/4-5-8-11, Superfecta 4-7/4-7-11/ALL/4-5-7-8-11**
