

STEVE FIERRO'S RACEDAY USA BETTING LINE

Today's Racing Digest now features a betting line. A betting line is the second quarter of a complete handicapping/investing process. The betting line is applied following contender selection. This is outlined in Steve's book *"The Four Quarters of Horse Investing"*.

PLEASE READ THE ITEMS LISTED BELOW

The betting line is simple and easy to use. It is designed to point out the value opportunities in a race.

Here are the recommendations or "best way" to use the betting line:

1. The top contender is offered at odds higher than listed on the betting line (overlaid). This is the strongest feature of the betting line.
2. If two contenders are overlaid, start at the top. The contender listed closest to the top is the play. If the two are above 8/1, play them both.
3. If three contenders are overlaid the race is a pass. The race is chaos and long term this is a losing situation.
4. Legitimate favorites: If the betting line lists the top contender at 3/2 or less and the betting public sends this contender to post at 3/2 or less, this race must also be passed. This is a strong contender. The other contenders become "false overlays" because of the heavy action on the "legitimate" favorite. They do win, but long term they pay far too little to produce a profit.

Exotics: The betting line is a "win oriented" service. It is an excellent tool in constructing doubles, Pick 3's, and 4's, from a value standpoint.

If Espinoza can get a clear early lead with Inanewyorksecond they may never look back. Let's stick with the gate tow wire call.

3rd race

Knapp has Reasonably Brite on a nice improving race pattern. If this pattern continues with this move to the main track, they could be a nice value play.

4th race

Baffert sends Appearance Fee to the claimers for the first time versus winners. They could make it 3 for 4 today.

5th race

Present the Cork	2/1
Majestic Avenue	3/1
High Z	7/2

Present the Cork has been working well for this debut race. Even with the rail draw I will play him if I am offered 5/2 or better.

6th race

Tradition Rocks	2/1
Fabulous Groom	4/1
Military Academy	6/1
Fabulous West	6/1

John Martin continues to be solid of the claim. This is with a huge sample of runners. So I can back him even on the Southern California side of the state with his new runner, Tradition Rocks

7th race

Snapped Up	9/5

We backed Snapped Up last start. I think this colt is worth backing once again if the right price is offered.

8th race

Salah Love sure won like a gal that can head right on through this first allowance condition. She will not be 21/1 for this race however.

9th race

We have a pretty wide open race as a finale. I will start at the top with Slew La La. It will be close but we may not have to look any further.

The best price between the solid veteran runners Bonaquil and Priest River is the way to go here in the opener.

2nd race

We come right back with another race that has three evenly matched runners on the betting line. We will use the same strategy as race one. Play the best price between them.

3rd race

Always Remember	9/5

Diaz makes a confident move up the claiming ladder following the big win with Always Remember. I say let's go right along with him.

4th race

Cheetah Chat	9/5
Notarized	3/1
Ricardo Voador	4/1

Cheetah Cat is a solid top contender. Unfortunately he is no secret. The running line from his last race will have him backed heavily as well.

5th race

Built For The Lady	2/1
Expensivekahlua	4/1
C. J. Hawk	6/1
Quaqmire	6/1

Built For The Lady made two moves in her debut race. I think she can handle this slight move up the ladder.

6th race

Rachel's Verdict	2/1

Let's play Rachel's Verdict on the stretch out here in the sixth.

7th race

We have another tight three horse betting line here in the seventh. This one is a bit different. I am partial to Ruttini.

8th race

The top two listed runners are on a roll. I give the slight edge to Dramatic Chance.

9th race

Compulsive	9/5

Baffert got the debut win from Compulsive last year at Del Mar. They return here in the north and look well spotted to post win number two.

10th race

Sir Toasty	5/2

There certainly is nothing wrong with the last race turf debut of Sir Toasty. I think this second try over the grass will produce win number three.

11th race
